Conduct Policy

It is the policy of Northwest Youth Baseball & Softball to promote the development of strong character, a positive attitude, a sense of responsibility, and good citizenship in its players. It is the purpose of Northwest Youth Baseball & Softball to achieve this goal through fair play, good sportsmanship and congenial fellowship, with adult leaders providing a respectable, safe and enjoyable atmosphere for all. It is strictly against the policy of Northwest Youth Baseball & Softball for any person, either as a participant or a spectator, to engage in arguments, to use abusive language, to harass Umpires, Managers, Coaches, Players, Board Members or other spectators, or to exhibit any behavior not in keeping with the above.

Sportsmanship Policy

Members of one team shall not ride, kid, heckle, poke fun at or in any other manner do anything that in the opinion of the Umpire or Field Director distracts the opposing team. The penalty for violation of this rule shall be removal of the guilty players, parents and/or Manager/Coaches for the remainder of the game. Continued acts of unsportsmanlike conduct shall be subject to further action by the Board of Directors.

- **I will place the emotional and physical well being of the children ahead of my personal desire to win.**
- **I will remember that the game is for youth – not adults.**
- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for the children on my Team and all other children participating in league activities by following this Code of Conduct.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, Coaches and Officials at every game, practice or other league events.
- I will insist that my children play in a safe and healthy environment.

I have read and will abide by all the conditions set forth in the Northwest Conduct and Sportsmanship policy.

I understand if I violate these policies, I could be subject to removal from Northwest fields by Northwest Officials.
