Conduct Policy

It is the policy of Northwest Youth Baseball & Softball to promote the development of strong character, a positive attitude, a sense of responsibility, and good citizenship in its youngsters. It is the purpose of Northwest Youth Baseball & Softball to achieve this goal through fair play, good sportsmanship and congenial fellowship, with adult leaders providing the example while attempting to limit injury. It is strictly against the policy of Northwest Youth Baseball & Softball for any person, either as a participant or a spectator, to engage in arguments, to use abusive language, to harass Umpires, Managers, Coaches, Players, Board Members or other spectators, or to exhibit any behavior not in concert with the general intention of this policy statement.

Sportsmanship Policy

Members of one team shall not ride, kid, heckle, poke fun at or in any other manner do anything that in the opinion of the Umpire or Field Director distracts the opposing team. The penalty for violation of this rule shall be removal of the guilty players and/or Coach and/or Manager from the game and from the dugout.

- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Code of Conduct.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, Coaches and Officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will remember that the game is for youth – not adults.
- I will ask my child to enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with Coaching, or providing transportation.

I have read and will abide by all the conditions set forth in the Northwest Conduct and Sportsmanship policy.

I understand if I violate these policies, I could be subject to removal from Northwest fields by Northwest Officials.
